

Transition Programs offered by Post-Secondary Institutions

Often Colleges and Universities have transition programs for students with learning needs (not restricted to learning disabilities) often in the summer (can also be through the academic school year) that are open to all students (even if the student is not attending that particular college or university).

Some programs are funded by the province and are free if the student attends the program. Things that are usually covered are learning and studying strategies, assistive technologies, information about university life/services, advocacy skills.
